The Weyburn PS are investigating a report of a possible fraud regarding a door-to-door sales purchase.

We wish to remind everyone that if a door-to-door salesperson calls on you ,you have the right to demand identification and proof of City and Provincial licence. You also have the legal right to terminate the contract so long as you do it within 10 days.

April 26th

The Weyburn PS received a report that a tenant at a hotel had caused damage to the room. The matter is still under investigation.

April 28th

The Weyburn PS received a complaint regarding the use of vulgar and inappropriate language being used in a public setting. After investigation an 18 year old female has been charged under the Bylaw for using vulgar language in public.

At about 6:10pm the Weyburn PS received a complaint regarding a man in a residential area who appeared to be passed out. A 47 year old male was located and lodged in cells for being drunk in public. He was released when sober.

April 30th

The Weyburn PS received a complaint about a fight at a local bar. By the time the police arrived the incident was over and the people had left the area. Within a short time one of those involved, a 21 year old male, returned to the bar and tried to get back in and was refused. He was arrested for drunk in public and held in cells until sober.
