# July 18<sup>th</sup>

At about 3:15 pm the Weyburn PS was called to a report of a domestic disturbance between a 35 year old female and 36 year old male. The matter was mediated.

## July 20th

The Weyburn PS has received a number of complaints about internet or telephone scams. One involved a 'Secret Shopper' scam. The other involved an iTunes card scam. The Police Service continues to stress that you have to be diligent in researching these activities. As most of these scams are centered off-shore if you do become a victim with an actual loss of money it is extremely difficult for the police to investigate and assist you.

At about 1:30 pm the Weyburn PS responded to a 3-vehicle collision at 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 9<sup>th</sup> Street. There were minor injuries but nothing requiring EMS. A 47 year old female driver was issued a Traffic Ticket for driving without due care & attention.

The Weyburn PS received a complaint regarding a domestic situation that had resulted in Threats being uttered. A 28 year old male has been charged with Uttering Threats and will be making a Court appearance.

## July 21<sup>st</sup>

At about 8:45pm as the result of a traffic stop a 21 year old male driver was issued a 72 hour driving suspension for driving under the influence of alcohol.

# July 22<sup>nd</sup>

At about 8:20 am the Weyburn PS was dispatched to a report of a Break & Enter in progress. After attending and conducting the investigation it was learned that this resulted from a domestic situation between a 44 year old male and a 31 year old female. The matter was mediated.
