

### September 13<sup>th</sup>

- The Weyburn PS is investigating a number of commercial Break & Enters over the weekend.

Anyone having any information about these incidents is asked to contact the Weyburn Police Service at 848-3250, or to call Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-8477.

- At about 9:20pm the Weyburn PS received a call regarding a male person who was apparently passed out in the downtown area. A 54 year old male was located and was arrested for being intoxicated in a public place. He was also charged with Breach of a Court Condition and will be making a Court appearance.

### September 15<sup>th</sup>

- At about 11:40pm a Member of the Weyburn PS CTSS Unit conducted a traffic stop. This resulted in a 31 year old male being arrested and charged with Failing to Provide a Roadside Breath Sample. He will be making a Court appearance. If convicted, this offence carries the same penalty as being over .08 or driving while Impaired.

### September 16<sup>th</sup>

- While it seems like the CRA scam may have slowed for the time being, another scam has taken its place. The Weyburn PS is investigating a report of a fraudulent email scam where the computer owner is advised that the computer is in need of repair and to provide a credit card number. We wish to remind everyone that unless you have specifically initiated a business transaction on-line you should not provide any information to the other party until you verify that they are legitimate.
- The Weyburn PS received a report of an assault at a local sports facility. The matter is still under investigation but is an isolated incident with unique circumstances and no concern for the general safety of the community is present.

### September 18<sup>th</sup>

- At about 10:40 pm the Weyburn PS responded to a report of a minor domestic issue at a residence. As a result of being called back a 2<sup>nd</sup> time an 18 year old male was taken into custody and later released. No charges are pending.
