FIREARMS

- 2. (a) No person shall discharge a gun or other firearm, air gun, or any class or type thereof, or any bow and arrow, catapult or sling shot, in the City of Weyburn.
 - (b) No person shall carry a gun or other firearm, air gun or spring gun, or any class or type thereof, within the City of Weyburn while same is loaded.
 - (c) This Section shall not apply to any person having authority under a Statute of Canada or the Province of Saskatchewan to have in his possession a firearm and the discharge thereof within the scope of his duty, authority or occupation.
- 3. (a) The Chief of Police of the City of Weyburn is hereby authorized to issue a permit in writing to a recognized gun club, archery club or similar organization, entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities within designated areas of the City of Weyburn. Such a permit shall be valid for the then current year.
 - (b) The Chief of Police of the City of Weyburn is hereby authorized to issue a permit in writing to a person or persons, subject to the *Wildlife Act*, Statutes of Saskatchewan, Regulations W-13.1, to discharge a firearm within the corporate limits of the City of Weyburn for the destruction of rabbits, crows, pigeons and any other exigency. Such a permit shall be valid for a period not exceeding the then current year.
- 4. "Firearm" means any barreled weapon from which any shot, bullet or missile can be discharged and that is capable of causing serious bodily injury or death to the person, and includes anything that can be adapted for use as a firearm.
- 5. Any person who contravenes this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.00 and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding fourteen (14) days.
