

## **FIRECRACKERS AND FIREWORKS**

### **3. Prohibition**

No person shall set off any firecrackers or rockets in the City of Weyburn at any time whatsoever, provided that this section shall not apply to a fireworks display.

### **4. Displays**

- a. A fireworks display may only be held by a regularly constituted group, association or organization under supervision of a fit and competent person.
- b. A fireworks display shall be held only in public parks and other public places approved from time to time by resolution of the Council and shall be located at a safe distance from all highways, railroads, overhead wires, buildings or other structures and combustible material.
- c. No such group shall hold a firework display without first having given to the Chief of Police at least one weeks prior written notice of its intention to hold such display, which shall be signed by one of the officers or agents and shall show:
  - i) the names and address of the group and its officers in charge of the display;
  - ii) the date and place of the proposed display; and
  - iii) the name and qualifications of the person supervising the display.
- d. Such display shall be held at the time and place set out in the notice and under the direct supervision of the person named therein.
- e. A fireworks display shall be conducted in a manner consistent with all safety procedures and be held and continued only while all proper precautions are being observed to keep spectators at a safe distance, including the having of suitable fire extinguishers or other suitable means of extinguishing fires at hand.
- f. All unused fireworks and all debris shall be removed by the group holding the display, immediately after the display and safely disposed of.
