November 30

The Weyburn PS responded to a 2 vehicle collision at 3rd St NE and Bison Avenue. Neither vehicle was driveable, but there were no injuries. A 37 year old female was issued 2 traffic tickets; driving without a proper driver's licence and for proceeding before safe from a Yield Sign.

At about 3:50 pm a vehicle was stopped in relation to another incident. The 32 year old female driver was found to be under the influence of alcohol and provided a roadside breath sample. As a result of her reading she was issued a 3 day driving suspension.

December 2

In the early hours the Weyburn PS received a 911 call regarding a suspected domestic disturbance. Upon attending the police located a 23 year old female outside of the residence. A 23 year old male was located inside the residence and was arrested without incident. He is facing a charge of Assault.

December 3

At about 3:30 pm the Weyburn PS received numerous complaints about erratic driving. A vehicle description was given and the vehicle was eventually located. A teen is facing charges under the Traffic Safety Act.

December 5

In the early hours of the morning while on patrol the Police witnessed a vehicle being driven in an erratic manner. When stopped the driver was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was arrested for Impaired Driving. An 18 year old male has been charged and will be making a Court appearance.

December 6

Just after midnight, Weyburn PS was notified by the RCMP regarding an intoxicated person passed out in a local business. A 23 year old male was located and taken into custody and released when sober. No charges are pending.

The Weyburn PS is investigating a report of Mischief where a vehicle was damaged by eggs being thrown at it. The matter is still under investigation, but the police do have a suspect.
