# Weyburn Police Service Media Release February 14, 2016 to February 21, 2016

### February 15<sup>th</sup>

At about 6:55 pm the Weyburn PS became involved in an investigation into the theft of a pickup truck from the streets in Weyburn. During the next hours more information became available suggesting that the now stolen vehicle had been involved in other offences in and around the City. As a result, and assisted by the Weyburn RCMP, the accused was located on a farm in the Weyburn area and arrested without incident. He is facing charges of Theft of a Vehicle and Theft Under \$5000 from the Weyburn PS and may be facing charges from the Weyburn RCMP as well.

### February 16<sup>th</sup>

At about 7:00 am the Weyburn PS were called to a report of a domestic dispute. Upon arrival both parties were uncooperative and would not provide sufficient information to allow the police to continue the investigation.

The Weyburn PS are investigating a theft of property from a motor vehicle. This occurred sometime during the late evening of February 15<sup>th</sup> or early morning of the 16<sup>th</sup> in the Government Road area. Anyone with any information is asked to contact either the Weyburn PS, or to call Crime Stoppers.

At about 12:40 pm the Weyburn PS received a call regarding a person who was in medical distress. The Weyburn PS assisted local EMS in transporting the 20 year old male to the hospital.

## February 17<sup>th</sup>

At about 2:45 pm the Weyburn PS were dispatched to a local business regarding a suspected shoplifter. While Police were present the 17 year old female was observed to leave the store with property that had not been paid for. She was arrested without incident and is now facing a charge of Theft Under \$5000.

At about 7:20 pm the Weyburn PS were dispatched to an unrelated business regarding a shoplifting complaint. As the result of the investigation a 35 year old male person was taken into custody without incident and an amount of property from the business recovered at the scene. The male is facing charges of Theft Under \$5000.

#### February 18<sup>th</sup>

At about 7:40 pm the Weyburn PS were dispatched to a report of a vehicle collision. Both vehicles were found not to be drivable and were towed from the scene. A 17 year old male has been issued a traffic ticket for Proceeding Before Safe To Do So.

#### February 20<sup>th</sup>

At about 11:40 pm the Weyburn PS received a call about and individual threatening to harm himself. The police subsequently transported a 60 year old male to the local hospital.

## February 21<sup>st</sup>

At about 4:50 am the Weyburn PS conducted a traffic stop for a driving violation. The 28 year old female driver was found to be driving under the influence of alcohol and was issued a 72 hour licence suspension. A 29 year old male passenger was issued a ticket for unlawfully having liquor in a motor vehicle.

At about 9:45 pm the Weyburn PS were dispatched regarding a potential domestic disturbance. Upon arrival Police located a 25 year old male who was upset that he could not gain entry to the residence. The matter was mediated and the person given a ride.
