

PRESS RELEASE FOR JANUARY 2, 2017 to JANUARY 8, 2017

January 2

At about 7:15 pm the Weyburn PS was dispatched to a residence regarding a domestic dispute between a 50 year old male and a 51 year old female. Upon their arrival other family members had already arrived and the male left with family members. Alcohol was a contributing factor. No other police involvement was necessary.

At about 9:20 pm the Weyburn PS was dispatched to a residence regarding a domestic issue. Upon arrival they located a 31 year old male who was arrested for being intoxicated in public and was held in cells until sober.

January 5

At about 5:25 pm the Weyburn PS received information regarding a possible drinking driver. The vehicle was located and stopped. As a result a 43 year old female was arrested at the scene and has been charged with both Impaired Driving and Driving Over .08. Her driver's licence has been suspended indefinitely pending a conclusion in Court and the vehicle was impounded for 30 days.

The Weyburn PS received a complaint regarding harassing social media messages involving a 34 year old female victim and a 17 year old female. The matter is still under investigation.

We repeatedly advise people that hiding behind social media posts does not protect someone from possible Bylaw charges for electronic bullying or from possible criminal prosecution where appropriate.

January 7

At about 11 am the Weyburn PS responded to a domestic dispute between a 30 year old female and a 28 year old male. The matter was mediated without further need for police involvement and counseling was arranged.

January 8

At about 2:30 am the Weyburn PS conducted a traffic stop. As the result of the stop a 19 year old male was arrested at the scene and is now facing charges of Impaired Driving and Driving Over .08. His licence has been indefinitely suspended pending an outcome in Court and his vehicle was impounded for 30 days.

The Weyburn PS received a complaint regarding harassing messages posted on social media. The matter was investigated and found to be unfounded.

At about 1:25 am the Weyburn PS conducted a traffic stop. As a result a 19 year old male was charged with driving an unregistered vehicle (\$580.00 fine) and with Driving While Suspended (Court Appearance).
